- educational benefits are available to qualifying Vietnam, Desert Storm and Desert Shield veterans, as well as those returning from Iraq and Afghanistan?
- if you are enrolled in the VA healthcare system, you are exempt from the penalty of the Affordable Care Act, and you can sign up for VA benefits any time, with no deadline?
- each VA medical center nationwide employs a Women Veterans Program Manager to advise and advocate for women veterans by assisting in coordinating health services such as primary care, specialized care for chronic conditions and reproductive health, including maternity care?

Learn about these benefits and more!

Veterans of all eras are encouraged to attend this town hall meeting and get information about applying for VA benefits, such as disability compensation, pensions, and burials, as well as additional benefits offered by New York City and State.

Following the morning question-and-answer session, veterans will have the opportunity to sign up for VA benefits on the spot.
